How Does It Work?

A Broker would spend time getting to know the person, their current lifestyle and how they might want this to change.

The Broker would then explore means to provide the support through their knowledge of communities and existing networks.

Where someone is eligible for statutory services a Broker can assist the person to explore Self Directed Support Options so the person can make the best decision for them.

COMMUNITY Brokerage



Support Choices are working in partnership with Perth and Kinross HSCP to deliver social care using a Community Brokerage approach.

What Is Community Brokerage?

Community Brokerage can assist people who have social care needs to think about what support might improve their lives and then help them access this.

Where Would the Support Come From?

The support might be available within the community such as groups or organised activities, it might require application for funding through grants or Independent Living Fund or it may require access to statutory service. (ilf.scot)
